REVIEW

The 2015 Braedyn check sin as 68% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 4% each of Malbec, Cabernet Franc, and Petit Verdot that spent 46 months in 60% new French oak. It reveals a dense purple/plum color as well as a ripe, opulent, full-bodied style that's handled the élevage nicely. Giving up lots of plum and darker currant and blackberry fruits, it has notes of toasted spice, chocolate, and baking spices, supple tannins, and a great finish. The balance is spot on, and it delivers a deep, layered mid-palate as well as a big finish. This singular wine should evolve for at least a decade, although it's mature and drinking great today.
